Some general information about the timetables below:

Lessons in Austria last for 50 Minutes. Teachers move to different classes and classrooms for each lesson. The first column in the timetable indicates the class and the subject, the second column refers to the room where this class takes place.

Austria restarts numbering classes with 1 after primary school. That means, for example, that students in 1a are actually in their 5 year of education and around 10 years old. Students in 8b are about to graduate after 12 years of education and are around 18 years old. Please be advised that you are visiting us in the last week of school for our graduating classes (8 abcdef), who will take their final exams in the first week of May. Experience tells us that in the weeks before finals attendance is generally very low and the lessons are rather atypical, as we will just do exam preparation with past papers. We recommend picking other classes for observation.
